



The travel and Tourism Department is based on the lower ground floor of Bryn Hafren School. This is where all our lessons are held.

There is one classroom available to us which has 18 computers for use in producing portfolio work. Colour printing is used to present final portfolio pieces.

Mrs Gordon is responsible for delivering all aspects of the A Level course.

In the first year of a two year course you will study three modules of work. This could result in you achieving an AS in Travel and Tourism.

## What is the Course All About?

In the first year of study we will complete three modules of work.

**Module one** concentrates on an investigation into the Travel and Tourism Industries. This module is assessed by a 1½ hour external examination which will test your knowledge of the subject generally.



**Module two** focuses on customer service in travel and tourism and we will research a major hotel in the area. You will produce a portfolio of work for assessment.

**Module three** is destination Europe in which we study and produce a portfolio on major destinations, transport and design a holiday package for a group of customers.

## YEAR 2

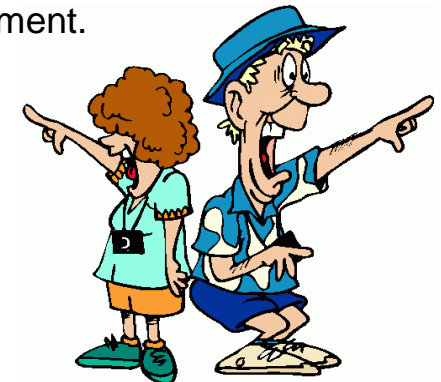
In the second year of study we complete three modules of work.

**Module four** is learning about responsible tourism.

This module is assessed by a 1½ hour external examination which will test your knowledge of the subject generally.

**Module five** is a research project on current issues in tourism such as global warming, terrorism and e-tourism. You will produce a portfolio of work for assessment.

**Module six** gives you the opportunity to study special interest holidays and you can choose what interests you to study. You will produce a portfolio of work for assessment.

Travel and Tourism is another subject that you can get A Level or AS level accreditation just the same as many other A Level subjects.

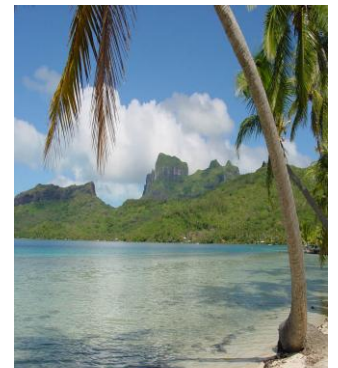
